

METAL: All ferrous metal must be primed with an appropriate metal primer.

VINYL: Vertical vinyl surfaces may be coated, but the new colour must be equal to or lighter than the existing colour. Colours that are darker than the existing colour may lead to warping or permanently damage the vinyl itself. A bonding primer would be recommended for maximum performance.

COMPOSITE: Composite decking may be coated, but newer style composite decking that is wrapped/capped in a solid vinyl shell, must be primed with STEINA Stain Blocking Primer or an appropriate bonding primer.

APPLICATION

Always test a small area before application to the entire surface.

Stir thoroughly before and during application to insure uniform appearance. Material should be intermixed by pouring into a large container and stirring before painting large areas, to insure colour uniformity.

PRIMED WOOD: Apply 1 to 2 finish coats of unthinned stain.

BARE WOOD: Apply a base coat of stain thinned with approx. 500 ml of water per gallon, then apply 1 to 2 finish coats of unthinned stain.

TOOLS: Apply evenly with a quality nylon or synthetic brush maintaining a wet edge. Start at the end of boards and go along surfaces to a break point to avoid lapping. If spraying, back brush immediately. This product may also be applied by roller or pad applicator.

CLEAN-UP: Clean tools and equipment immediately with warm soapy water.

COLOURS

Light colours may have a green cast for a few months as the preservatives leach from the wood. Decking stain colours vary with the different varieties of wood. Samples should be tested on the actual wood being used before large areas of wood are stained.
